Midianites = Strife, Contention

Amalekites = People of the valley who steal your mountain top blessings

Judges 6:

 - a. Enemy Prevailed. (6:1)
 - b. Lived in Fear Hiding in Caves away from their Homes. (6:2)
 - c. Enemies Destroyed their Possessions
 - d. Israel Lived in Total Poverty
- 2. Israel Cried unto the Lord, (vv. 6,7)
- 3. The Prophetic Voice, (Amos 3:7)
- 4. The Lord Himself Appears to Gideon Yahweh-Shalom first time in OT
- 5. Gideon's Conversion:
 - a. Gideon's Commendation "The Lord is with you
 - b. Gideon's Complain and Cry, (v.13)
 - c. Gideon's Call to Arms "Go in this My Might" (v. 14)
 - d. Gideon's Confirmation "Peace be unto you, Fear not, you shall not die" (V. 23).
 - e. Gideon's Consecration breaking the bondages of his family influence.
- f. Gideon's Corroboration of God's Call upon his Life, (vv. 37-40) (Making more certain sure of authority)

Judges 7

6. Call and Choosing of the Remnant (7:1-8)

300 (.96%) corporately committed men = 3×100 , 3 is the number of the Godhead and 100 is the number of fruitfulness.

- 9. Call to "Arise" against Midian and all the Host, (v.15)
- 10. Weapons of Warfare, v.16: Trumpet, (1 Cor. 14:7); Pitchers, (2 Cor. 4:7); Lamps, (Mat. 5:14).
- 11. Divine Discipline-"... They stood every man in his own place round about the camp"
 (3 Companies of 100 = 300)
- 12. Divine Direction: "Look unto Me and do Likewise," (vv. 17-18
- 13. Divine Destruction by divine sound and light
