Recognizing false Christian teachers

How to discern between counterfeit Christian leaders and those who are genuine

Part I Jezebel of Thyatira

- 1. Revelation 2:18-29 Whose words are these?
- 2. What praise does he have for the church in Thyatira?
- 3. What correction does he have for the members of this congregation?
- 4. What are the teachings that are leading them into sin? (Compare the correction of the church in Pergamum. Revelation 2:14-16.)
- 5. Jude 3, 4; 2 Pet. 2- What did these godless men teach?
- 6. What is the penalty for those who refuse to act on this correction? Compare to Revelation 2:22-23 and Romans 6:23.
- 7. What is the reward for those who persevere in turning away from teachings that are in opposition to God's instructions? See also Luke 19:17

Part II Queen Jezebel, Ahab's Wife

- 1. I Kings 16:30-34 What was Ahab's spiritual condition?
- 2. I Kings 18:4 What was Jezebel doing?
- 3. I Kings 18:20-40 What was Elijah's challenge to the people? (v. 21) What was Elijah's prayer? (v. 37)
- 4. I Kings 19:1-18 How did God encourage Elijah? (v. 18) Compare with Revelation 2:24.
- 5. I Kings 21:1-26 How did Jezebel use her political and religious power?
- 6. I Kings 21:23-24; II Kings 9:30-37 What was Jezebel's end? Compare with Revelation 2:22-23.
- 7. Jude 12-16 Compare Jezebel's actions with the false (counterfeit) teachers described by Jude.

Part III How to tell the genuine from the counterfeit

- 1. Matthew 7:15-29 What warning did Jesus give to his disciples?
- 2. Are false prophets easy to recognize? (v.15) Compare to II Corinthians 11:13-15.
- 3. What did Jesus say would reveal the true from the false? (Matthew 7:16-20) Compare to Galatians 5:19-26. What fruit do you think Jesus was talking about?
- 4. Who did Jesus say would enter his kingdom? Who would not? (Matthew 7:21)
- 5. Can we rely on powerful preaching, control over demonic forces, or even miracles to tell who are the true representatives of Christ? (v.22-23) Compare to Deuteronomy 13:1-18.
- 6. Jude 11-12, 16-19 What are some of the motives of counterfeit religious leaders?
- 7. I Corinthians 5:9-13 How did Paul apply Deuteronomy 17:7 to a congregation?
- 8. Romans 8:12-14; Colossians 3:5-11 How do we apply Deuteronomy 17:7 to ourselves personally?

Part IV How to avoid being deceived

- 1. Matthew 7:24-27 How can we as followers of Christ, as women in Christ, be certain that we remain disciples of Jesus?
- 2. Who has the ultimate authority to teach us God's instructions? Jesus? Or human religious leaders? (v.28-29)
- 3. Jude 4 What are two false teachings we must reject?
- 4. Jude 20-23 Name four things in this passage you can do to maintain your relationship with God.
- 5. Jude 24-25 Who can we trust to guard us from those who would lead us away from the true way of God?
